# OUR PRIORITIES



The event was attended by 65 people - residents of Zaporizhzhia, Mykhailo-Lukashivska and other communities of Zaporizhzhia region. Thanks to close cooperation with the community, the plants are taken care of.

# «BORN TO BE ONESELF»

15.07.2024-15.10.2024

Donor: "Government of the Faroe Islands"

The Born to be oneself project was implemented in Zaporizhzhia Oblast from August to October 2024. Its goal was to support the mental and physical health of girls from vulnerable groups. We managed to help 330 participants, including IDPs, people with disabilities and those who lost loved ones.

Art therapy, leadership seminars, psychological trainings, 330 hygiene kits and 260 hours of individual counseling were provided. The girls gained emotional stability, leadership skills, self-confidence and support. The project was an important step towards strengthening their well-being and motivation.

# OPERATIONAL SUPPORT 2024-2025 UNDER THE SMALL GRANTS PROGRAM FOR PIN PARTNERS

1.09.2024- 30.11.2024

Donor: People In Need

This project has become an important experience for the organization, allowing not only to achieve its goals but also to identify areas for further development and improvement.

The project goal was achieved:

- The replacement of windows in the main office space provided a significant increase in energy efficiency, comfortable working conditions for employees and beneficiaries.
- Volunteers received winter kits (hats, mittens, thermal socks), which increased their comfort and readiness to work in the winter.
- Providing fuel for the generators and purchasing rechargeable flashlights allowed the organization to function smoothly even during power outages and blackouts that occurred after the shelling.

The project is being implemented thanks to our partners from the humanitarian organization "People in Need" and the financial support of the Czech people.



# EMERGENCY EVACUATION ASSISTANCE AND ACCESS TO BASIC SERVICES FOR VULNERABLE GROUPS

1.11.2024-28.02.2025



**The project has started and is currently underway. Geography: Matviyivska, Mykhailivska, Mykhailo-Lukashivska, Petro-Mykhailivska, Bilenkivska communities. Donor - People In Need. Assistive devices were provided to 453 people, including 362 residents of the Petro-Mykhailivska community and 91 residents of the Matviyivska community. Transportation services for people with limited mobility were provided. Group consultations on the use of assistive devices and care for people with reduced mobility and group psychosocial support sessions were held.**

# **STRENGTHENING THE ROLE OF LOCAL AID PROVIDERS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF HUMANITARIAN AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS**

Since 1.12.2024, the project has been implemented as part of the Small Grants Program for PIN partners.
